

## **60 NEWSPAPERS**

- 60.01 It shall be the policy of the City and County of Denver in the operation of the Municipal Airport System to assure the traveling public the maximum convenience in utilization of the facilities at the Airport, including but not limited to: easing the problems of pedestrian traffic flow by removing physical obstacles, providing easy access to concession areas and goods, and providing an attractive and pleasant atmosphere within the limited physical confines of the Airport. Additionally, it shall be the policy of the City and County of Denver to assure the traveling public reasonable and convenient access to newspapers and other amenities while utilizing the facilities of the Airport.
- 60.02 It shall further be the policy of the City and County of Denver in the operation of the Municipal Airport System to meet the obligations of the bonding ordinances, under which the City is obligated now and in the future, to maximize the revenues that the City and County receives from the operation of the Municipal Airport System.
- 60.03 To achieve the stated objectives, the distribution of newspapers will be permitted through the City's concessionaires at the newsstands and by the use of newsracks operated by the newspapers or their distributors at appropriate locations specified by the Manager.
- 60.04 The newspapers will purchase newsracks and enclosures of a uniform type and color as specified by the Airport Engineer's office. The newspapers which use these racks will be responsible for the cleaning and maintenance of the newsracks and mechanisms involved. Freestanding newsracks are not permitted in the Terminal or concourses. Any freestanding newsrack in the Terminal or concourses shall be removed immediately by the owner upon notification or it shall be confiscated by the Director of Aviation.
- 60.05 In the tenant-leased areas (non-public access), the newspapers shall provide their own vending machines without any other restrictions; provided that the location of any newsracks in the tenant-leased areas shall be reported to the Property Office and the concession fees shall be paid to the Airport.
- 60.06 Locations for newsracks shall be subject to adjustment, relocation, or other changes in the discretion of the Manager for reasons of increased traffic flow, interruption of pedestrians, safety, construction, or renovation.
- 60.07 Newsrack locations in the Terminal or the concourses shall be placed so as to assure that all passengers will be within a reasonable distance of a news rack or news stand.
- 60.08 The location of all newsstands and newsrack locations on the concourses, baggage level and the Terminal shall be indicated by appropriate signage.

- 60.09 All newsstands shall, as a requirement of the newsstand concession contract, provide a prominent display area which shall be visible from the exterior of the stand where the newspapers shall be exhibited. Such display shall be changed at least daily so that the headlines shall be prominently exhibited to the public.
- 60.10 No concessionaire shall charge a price higher than the premarked price of the newspaper for any edition, including Sunday.
- 60.11 All location of space in the recessed areas will be based on available space and the newspapers shall be assigned specific locations and numbers of racks at those locations by the Director of Aviation. Such locations will be identified in the concession contract between the newspaper and the City. Such locations shall not be assignable without the prior approval of the Director of Aviation.
- 60.12 Any newspaper wishing to sell or distribute newspapers other than through the newsstands must obtain a contract or permit from the City. Placement of newsracks on Airport property without written permission is prohibited.
- 60.13 Use of motorized carts for distribution shall be solely by permit and in accordance with Airport regulations governing use of carts.
