

REPEAL OF
PART 200 – AIRCRAFT DEICING SYSTEM FEES AND CHARGES
AIRPORT RULES AND REGULATIONS


Part 200 of the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Operation, Control and Use of the Denver Municipal Airport System (“Airport Rules”), concerning Aircraft Deicing System Fees and Charges, was adopted effective February 28, 1995, to allow the Department of Aviation to collect fees and charges required to recover its capital costs of constructing the Airport’s deicing system.

The Department of Aviation has now recovered those capital costs, and no longer collects fees and charges for that purpose. Other provisions of the Airport Rules, including Parts 120 and 190, address aircraft deicing operations and the fees and charges now assessed for airline use of Airport facilities.

Part 200 of the Airport Rules is no longer necessary, and therefore it is hereby repealed, effective July 31, 2006.

Persons maintaining notebooks of Airport Rules should insert this statement of repeal in place of the Part 200 rules.
